## Rotary Club outlines electrical hazards

CLEAR LAKE - The Space Center Rotary Club Community Safety Committee advises that electricity, when properly used, is man's good and faithful servant. It makes our job and our life easier, safer, and more fun.

Electrical hazards are all about us. The use of electricity for power, light, and processing operations is so universal that we accept it with only an occasional thought of its ability to harm or destroy. Electricity has eliminated many hazards that were present when work was done by human muscles or by mechanical power, but in turn it has created hazards of its own.

Home use of electricity has quadrupled in the last few years as people use more electricity in the home and on the job. This has resulted in the majority of homes being inadequately wired. Inadequate or improper wiring cases about one out of eight home fires.

Scientists have invented a machine that they can put grass into and produce milk - bypassing the cow. Now they claim they can do the same with a machine made egg - bypassing the the hen. When they start bypassing parents and babies to produce instant teenagers - LET'S BAIL OUT (Scandal Sheet)

As on numerous times in the past it is always good to see Bill walk in on us!

The following are some things everyone should check to help eliminate electrical firet:

- 1. Do lights dim when an appliance goes on?
- 2. Do motors slow down?
- 3. Do fuses blow frequently?
- . Do you need more circuits?
- 5. Do toasters or irons fail to heat properly?
- 6. Does TV picture shrink?
- 7. Are switches and outlets properly insulated?
- 8. Are you short of outlets?
- 9. Are light bulbs unprotected?
- 10. Are outlets overcrowded or circuits overfused?
- 11. Are motors dirty or neglected?
- 12. Is wiring temporary or makeshift?
- 13. Are cords, switches, or plugs damaged?
- 14. Are appliances worn or defective?
- 15. Is ordinary" or "explosion-pro f" electrical equipment used where flammable vapors are present?
- 16. Are combustibles kept apart from appliances: i.e., light bulbs, heating units, etc.?
- 17. Are extension cords too light for the load?
- 18. Are fuses with too high amperage rating being used?

Wiring should be installed and checked by a qualified electrician to comply with National Electrical Code, National Electrical Safety Code, and state and local ordinances. Appliances should be approved by Underwriters. Laboratory or other authorized laboratories.
