PAST PROGRAMS....On February 1, JIM WYATT introduced DR. DON BEETH, Director of Nuclear Information at Houston Lighting and Power Company who gave a very interesting and informative talk on all the things we need to know about nuclear power. He assured the audience that all of the newspaper articles on the dangers at nuclear power plants are misleading. Through a series of demonstrations he showed how an individual contacted more radiation from common everyday household articles than anyone would that was close to the Three Mile Nuclear Plant. Dr. Beeth stressed the need for more nuclear power plants to relieve the dependency upon fossile fuels. He also stressed that scientists have discovered ways to dispose of nuclear waste that will not contaminate the environment. If you missed this program, you really missed an outstanding program on a topic of vital importance to everyone....Then on February 9th, AARON SCHEIN introduced FRED PORTNER, Senior Vice President of Southwest Bankshares who discussed the history and development of bank holding companies in the State of Texas. He cited the importance of these companies was in their ability to combine assets and thereby be able to financially serve large companies and industries. Even tho there are eight major bank holding businesses in Texas, the largest one only has control over 15% of the market. If fact there are over 1,000 independent bankers in the State. He finished his remarks with the prediction that the inflation rate will be at 6% by the end of 1982 and should be down to around 2% by the end of 1985. HOW TO GET OUT ALIVE WHEN HOTELING/MOTELING The precautions to take if you are a guest..

When you check in locate at least two emergency exits, count the doors to each exit so you can find them if the lights go out. a flashlight may save your life.

If there is smoke present, wrap a wet towel

around nose and mouth. Don't walk, crawl.

If a fire breaks out, keep your room key and go to one of the exits. If there is smoke or heat, go to another exit.

Do not use elevator. If the power goes off you will be a smiked herring, or a dead duck.

If you remain in your room never open a door if it is hot.

Seal door and window cracks and ventilation grills to keep smoke out.

Wet down walls and furnishings.

Never break glass in window. If you need to signal for help open the window and wave a sheet.

The pictures from the Las Vegas fire showed people being picked up from the roof by helicopters. They had been blocked from going down by fires in the emergency exits, so found their way to the roof.

Remember, in the event of a fire in a hotel, your only job is to get out ALIVE!
