

APRIL IS A TIME TO PROMOTE PAUL HARRIS FELLOWS

April, the month in which Paul Harris was born, is an appropriate time to honor Rotary's Founder by promoting Paul Harris Fellows, and thus support the Foundation's goal of world peace. Annually, Paul Harris Fellow contributions account for more than two-thirds of the donations to the Foundation. In 1981-82 there were 13,333 new Paul Harris Fellows.

An individual who contributes US\$1,000 or more within a twelve-month period is designated a Paul Harris Fellow. A person who agrees to contribute \$1,000 over the recommended 10-year period of time with a minimum first contribution of \$100, will be recognized as a Paul Harris Sustaining Member. When the contributions reach a total of \$1,000, he or she will be designated a Paul Harris Fellow and receive the appropriate certificate and insignia. NEWS FLASH--20,000TH CLUB ADMITTED TO R.I.

R. I. President Hiroji Mukasa announced at an intercity meeting in Cannes, France, the admission of the 20,000th Rotary Club. This honor goes to the Rotary club of Saint-Hilaire-du-Harcouët, Manche, France. The new club, sponsored by the Rotary Club of Avranches (District 164), was organized on 31 October, 1982, and was admitted to the Rotary family on 3 March, 1983, with 21 charter members. Congratulations Saint-Hilaire-du-Harcouët!

As of this milestone date, there were an estimated 911,500 Rotarians in 157 countries and geographical regions, and since 1 July, 1982, 266 new clubs have been admitted in 43 countries.

Every Rotarian is expected to be a member of at least one committee within his club.

SPECIAL ROTARY MONTHS TO BE OBSERVED, BEGIN-NING IN 1983-84

The R.I. Board has agreed that beginning in the 1983-84 Rotary Year the Practice of observing "Special Rotary Weeks" will be replaced with "Special Rotary Months." Hence, effective 1 July, 1983, the month of September will be designated Youth Activities Month, October as Vocational Service Month, November as The Rotary Foundation Month, February as World Understanding Month, and April as Magazine Month.

This change will allow clubs more time to emphasize and publicize their programs and activities and provide them with greater flexibility.
