




MAKING UP-A ROTARY NECESSITY

The need for good attendance at club meetings is a rule of performance that Rotarians are reminded of over and over again. For attendance is the prime indicator of interest & without the sustained interest of its members, no Rotary club can exist in a healthy style.

Regular attendance is of major importance if members are to have first-hand knowledge of Rotary activities and if they are to maintain first-class participation in those activities.

Understandably, the penalties for poor attendance are severe. If a member misses four meetings in a row; if he fails to attend at least 30 percent of meetings of his own club each half year; or if he fails to attend a Rotary meeting somewhere at least 60 percent of the weeks during each sixmonth period; his membership is automatically terminated unless his absences have the specific approval of the club board of directors. There are legitimate excuses, of course and you will find them listed in Article VII, section 5, of the club constitution.
