

## Officer's Corner

Rotary International - Manual of Procedure - 1989

Rotary Club Constitution, page 223 "Section 5 - Termination - non-attendance" reads as follows:

"The membership of any member other than an honorary member of this club SHALL AUTOMATICALLY TERMINATE if without the consent of the Board for good and sufficient reason, he fails:

- (a) to attend or make up four consecutive regular meetings, or
- (b) to attend or make up at least sixty percent of the regular meetings in the first or second six months of the fiscal year, or
- (c) to attend at least thirty percent of the regular meetings of this club in the first or second six months of the fiscal year."

If a member knows he is going on a trip, or for any reason will miss the regular meeting, he should plan to make up at another club before leaving, while he is away, or as soon as he returns. A make up to be valid must be one week before or after the week of the missed regular meeting.

If a member is going to be in a situation where he believes he may not be able to make up, he should bring this to the attention of a club officer or Board Member. If a member is in a country that has no Rotary Club, he should make up as normal unless the stay is for longer than two weeks, in which case he should notify the club secretary.

If a member has one or more make-ups, he should be sure that the attendance book at the desk where he picks up his name tag is corrected to so indicate. For more imformation on attendance requirements, read the Rotary International Manual of Procedure, or ask the club secretary or an officer of the club. MEMBERSHIP ATTENDANCE IS IMPORTANT. BE A 100% MEMBER!
