- Use some for yourself and your family.

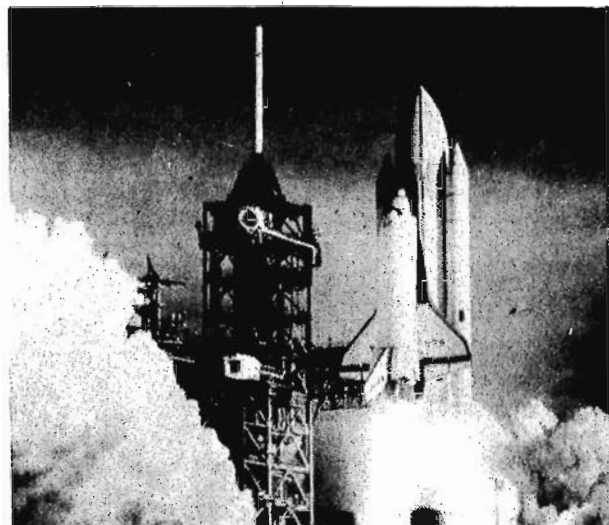
Try to see that people who are likely to participate in the auction "get to the party".

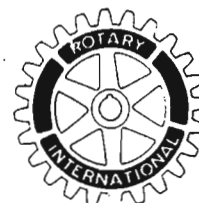
