About The Rotary Foundation

The Rotary Foundation is a not-for-profit corporation that supports the

:fforts of Rotary International to achieve world understanding and peace hrough international humanitarian, educational, and cultural exchange programs. It is supported solely by voluntary contributions from Rotarians and riends of the Foundation who share its vision of a better world.

The Foundation was created in 1917 by Rotary International's sixth presi-

lent, Arch C. Klumph, as an endowment fund for Rotary "to do good in the vorld." It has grown from an initial contribution of US\$26.50 to more than JS\$55 million contributed in 2002-03. Its event-filled history is a story of Rotarians learning the value of service to humanity. The Foundation's Humanitarian Programs fund international Rotary club

and district projects to improve the quality of life, providing health care, lean water, food, education, and other essential needs primarily in the dereloping world. One of the major Humanitarian Programs is PolioPlus, which eeks to eradicate the polio virus worldwide. Through its Educational Programs, the Foundation provides funding for some 1,200 students to study ibroad each year. Grants are also awarded to university teachers to teach in leveloping countries and for exchanges of business and professional people. 'ormer participants in the Foundation's programs have the opportunity to

continue their affiliation with Rotary as Foundation Alumni.


