Mitch Mitchell Space Astroids

Mitch Mitchell is President of Altair Development Corporation, a multi million dollar Real Estate Development Firm located in League City, TX.

Altair has developed numerous master planned communities, condominiums and office building projects in Pearland, Friendswood, and League City. He also has an operation in Gallatin, Tennessee, near Nashville.
