



## TODAY'S PROGRAM: CHRIS SCHAEFER

Chris Schaefer, Class of 1964, is a historian and Vietnam veteran with a long family history of military service. He holds a Bachelor's degree in History and a Master's degree in Comput-



ing Sciences, both from Texas A&M. In 1971b he founded a computer software company, and worked for twenty-two years as president of the company and as a consultant in wide area business communications.

In 1998 he sold his computer business and embarked on a second career as a historian. Following the diary of an American soldier who refused to surrender to the Japanese in World War II, he spent more than five years researching the war in the Pacific. Although he has authored many technical papers and presentations, Bataan Diary is his first commercial book. In the has defined the lives of real people caught up in a terribly orutal war. Here he follows their day to day personal lives, and also reveals the political and world influences which were going on around them. The result is a true story of struggle, intrigue and deception, as seen by the men and the women who lived through it.
