Mr. Gish earned a Bachelor of Arts degree in Political Science and a Masters Degree in Public Administration prior to beginning his NASA career. He joined NASA in 1980 as a Contract Specialist. Since that time, he has held progressively responsible positions including Space Shuttle Program Procurement Officer: Director of Acquisitions, International Space Station; and JSC Director of Procurement. Mr. Gish has received numerous honors and awards including the NASA Procurement Supervisor of the Year, the NSA Exceptional Service Medal and the NASA Outstanding Leadership Medal.


