STEVE SMITH

Born and raised in Southern Indiana, Steve Smith studied journalism at the University of Indiana in Bloomington. Following graduation, has erved for 2 years as an Intelligence Officer in the Juny. Then, he learned the broadcasting business on local Indiana TV.

In 1966, on a vacation to Houston, he landed a job at KPRC, channel 2. Soon, he anchored the 10:00 news and later the 5:00 news. He also wrote and produced both newscasts. For ten years, he wrote and hosted a public affairs program, Steve Smith's Sunday.

Mr. Smith spent 23 years at Channel 11. During that time he covered some of the major stories of the era: unar landings, the fall of the Berlin Wall, the Challenger explosion, plus some hurricanes, including Alicia.

It's career as a newsman has taken him all over the Id. He has traveled to the North Sea, British Isles, Japan, Singapore, Cairo, Kuwait, Paris and Vienna, to name a few.

Mr. Smith has contributed his time and talents to numerous charitable and arts groups in the Houston-Galveston area including the United Way, The Audubon Society, The Park People, Houston Grand Opera, Briarwood School, The Brookwood community, The Houston Symphony, Galveston's 1894 Grand Opera house, The Galveston Historical Foundation, Galveston's Ronald McDonald House, M.D. Anderson Cancer Center, St. Joseph Hospital and others. He has given his writing and talent work to Moody Gardens, Memorial Hermann Hospital System, Port of Houston, NASA/Johnson Space Center and others.

Mr. Smith retired from the news business in 1999 and formed a media consulting firm, Anchor Commy cations. When he is not working, he can be found fishing for flounder and speckled trout.
