### **Invocations & Prayers**

"Rotary clubs throughout the world include members who have many religious beliefs and values and are united in service to humanity. Each Rotary club, being autonomous, should use its own good judgment in conducting its meetings in a manner that reflects Rotary's basic principle of tolerance and encourages Rotarians' participation in humanitarian service projects. " [from the Rotary Manual of Procedure]

Certainly, Space Center Rotary Club in not a religious organization, but the club bylaws (Art. XIII) set forth the order of business for meetings. #3 in order is the "invocation". What is an "invocation"? Webster's New Collegiate Dictionary provides the following definition: "the act of calling upon God for blessing, help, inspiration, support, or the like; a formal prayer." It is not a time for a speech, political or otherwise. Nor is it a time for a moment of silence or or any statement that is not intended as an invitation to God to be present at the meeting and to invoke his blessing upon our activities. The dictionary does not tell us who "God" is and the invocator is given the freedom to determine to whom the invocation is directed. The three major world religions (Judaism, Islam & Christianity) claim the same God, Yahweh, Allah, God the Father. It is this members belief that the invocator should pray to the God of his or her religion and not attempt or pretend to speak or pray to a God or other Deity in whom the invocator does not believe just to be "politically correct". When you pray, pray sincerely, not just for show or piety or attempting to not offend someone. A person of faith will expect you to be honest in your prayer, even if their faith is different from yours. Rotarians should respect the right of everyone to believe as he or she chooses. We are a country of religious freedom --that is a founding tenet of America. However, this should not be a freedom to "fake it". If it is not your custom to pray or if you are uncomfortable with public prayer, decline to give the invocation.

This is merely the personal opinion of one member. You are free to disagree.




