

DID YOU KNOW?

Q. May a member be terminated for nonattendance?

A. Yes. A member must attend or make up at least 60% of this club's regular meetings in each half of the year; and must attend at least 30% of this club's regular meetings in each half of the year. If the member fails to attend as required, the member's membership shall be subject to termination unless the board consents to such non-attendance for good cause. Further, unless otherwise excused by the board for good and sufficient reason, a member who fails to attend or make up four consecutive regular meetings shall be informed by the board that the member's nonattendance may be considered a request to terminate membership in this club. Thereafter, the board, by a majority vote, may terminate the member's membership. There is an exception for any excused absence.



Paul Harris (1868-1947) Founder of Rotary

Born in Racine, WI; the 2nd of six children; Bachelor of Physical Culture & L.L.D degrees for the University of Vermont & L.L.B. Degree from the University of lowa; honorary Ph.D. From the University of Vermont; newspaper reporter, business teacher, stock company actor, cowboy, international seller of marble & granite, Lawyer. In 1900, after dinner with a lawyer friend, Paul Harris was impressed by the fact that his friend stopped at several shops and introduced him to proprietors who were his friends. This made him wonder about organizing a club which would band together a group of representative business & professional friends in fellowship. On Feb. 3, 1905, he formed the first club with three law clients. He named the club "Rotary" because the members met in rotation in their respective places of business.



Therefore, this Foundation has come into existence and shall strive to nurture, encourage, and advance the development of effective programs, activities, undertakings, and projects of a philanthropic, charitable, educational, humanitarian, and eleemosynary nature. To achieve this intent, the founders believe that it will be important and desirable for the Trustees of the Foundation to resist the temptations to distribute all available funds, but, at least in the early years, to concentrate on the building of a sizable trust corpus, accumulating as much of the income as possible and adding it to the principal until the Foundation has the means and resources to offer financial assistance to worthy projects of a far greater dimension than it would otherwise be able to consider.
