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ARTICLES OF INCORPORATION

THE ROTARY CLUB OF SPACE CENTER, HOUSTON, TEXAS

I, the undersigned natural person, who is of the age of eighteen (18) years or more, acting as incorporator of a corporation under the Texas Non-Profit Corporation Act, do hereby adopt the following Articles of Incorporation for such corporation:

ARTICLE I

Name

The name of the corporation shall be THE ROTARY CLUB OF SPACE CENTER, HOUSTON, TEXAS.

ARTICLE II

Non-Profit Corporation

This corporation is a non-profit corporation.

ARTICLE III

Duration

The period of its duration is perpetual.

ARTICLE IV

Purposes

The purposes for which the corporation is organized are to function as a service club or organization as defined in Section 501(c)(4) of the Internal Revenue Code of 1954 or current federal tax code, or corresponding section of any future federal tax code. Notwithstanding any other provision of these Articles, the corporation shall not carry on any other activities not

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permitted to be carried on by a non-profit corporation under the law and statutes of the State of Texas.

ARTICLE V

Members

The corporation shall have members in accordance with its constitution and bylaws.

ARTICLE VI

Initial Registered Office and Agent

The street address of the initial registered office of the corporation is 1300 Hercules, Houston Texas 77058, and the name of its initial registered agent at such address is Billy R. Smith.

ARTICLE VII

Board of Directors

The affairs of the corporation shall be managed by a Board of Directors. The qualifications, manner of selection, duties, terms, and other matters relating to the Board of Directors shall be provided in the bylaws. The initial Board of Directors shall consist of fifteen (15) persons. The number of Directors may be increased, or decreased, by adoption or amendment of bylaws.
