

Space Center Rotary Club To Hold Third Annual Shrimporee

LEAGUE CITY—The Space Center Rotary Club will hold its third annual Shrimporee from 3 to 8 p.m. Saturday, Sept. 18 at Galveston County Park on Highway 3.

The all-family event, which drew more than 3,000 persons last year, will feature "all the fried Gulf fish and shrimp you can eat" plus an auction with plenty of bargains, a club spokesman said.

The money raised by the Rotary Club will be distributed among several charities and area youth programs.

Proceeds from this year's Shrimporee will go to the following organizations: Edward H. White Memorial Youth Center (principal beneficiary this year), Bay Area Committee on Drug Abuse, Clear Lake Emergency Medical Corps,

Clear Creek Schools Scholarships, NASA Area Soccer League, International Seamen's Center, American Field Service, Boy Scouts of America, Earth Awareness Foundation, NASA Little League, Freeman Memorial Library, Clear Creek Pony-Colt League, Bay Area YMCA, America Legion Auxiliary (Girls State), Clear Creek Art League and Harris County Youth Village.

In addition to the fresh seafood, hush puppies, beans and cole slaw will be served, and soft drinks and beer will be available.

Some of the auction items include oil paintings, auto tires, boat accessories, sporting goods, Indian jewelry, bottles of wine and potted plants, all donated by Clear Lake area businessmen.

The biggest and probably most valuable item to be auctioned off will be a Saab automobile, donated by Norman Frede Chevrolet.

Advance tickets, costing \$4 for adults and \$2 for children, may be purchased at area banks and stores or from any Space Center Rotary Club member. Tickets bought at the gate will cost \$5 for adults and \$3 for children.
