Gentlemen:

This is to advise that, in accordance with the provisions of Article XIV, Section 4, of the Standard Rotary Club Constitution, this club at its regular meeting on December 1, 1980, agreed to the revision of its territorial limits as described in Article II, of its constitution as follows:

FROM

North: Fairmont Parkway from the intersection of Red Bluff Road to intersection with the South Belt and thence southwesterly along the South Belt to the Gulf Freeway (U.S. Route 75).

West: Gulf Freeway from South Belt to Clear Creek.

South: Clear Creek from Gulf Freeway to Kirby Road.

East: Kirby Road from Clear Creek to intersection of Red Bluff Road and thence northwesterly along Red Bluff Road to Fairmont Parkway.

TO

Beginning at the intersection of Red Bluff Road and Fairmont Parkway and thence westerly along Fairmont Parkway to South Belt, thence southwesterly along South Belt to the Gulf Freeway (Interstate 45) and thence southeasterly along the Gulf Freeway to Choate Road (FM 2351), and thence southwesterly along Choate Road to Clear Creek, and thence along the meanders of Clear Creek and the center line of Clear Lake to Kirby Road extended into Clear Lake, thence along Kirby Road to Red Bluff Road, and thence northwesterly along Red Bluff Road to the intersection with Fairmont Parkway and the point of beginning.

TERRITORIAL LIMITS OF SPACE CENTER ROTARY :Adopted May 20,1982

**Original Limits:**

**North:** Fairmont Parkway from intersection of Red Bluff Road to intersection with the South Belt and thence southwesterlly along the South Belt to the Gulf Freeway (Interstate-45)  
**West:** Gulf Freeway from South Belt to Clear Creek  
**South:** Clear Creek from Gulf Freeway to Galveston Bay  
**East:** From entrance to Clear Lake up Galveston Bay to Red Bluss Road; thence Red Bluff Road to Fairmont Parkway

After a review of the development of the area within the territorial limits of the club over the past ten years, plus the territory served by adjacent clubs and the business and social patterns that have developed within the Clear Lake/Bay Area community, it is requested that the territorial limits of the Rotary Club of Space Center be revised as follows:

**North:** No change  
**West:** Gulf Freeway from South Belt to Choate Road (FM 2351); thence Choate Road southwesterly to Clear Creek; thence south along Clear Creek to the Galveston County line  
**South:** Clear Lake from intersection of Harris and Galveston Counties to Galveston Bay  
**East:** No change
