Activities for which the Youth Committee dispersed funds, totalling about \$5000 during the year, were: \$650 check to Jane Corinne of BACODA for anti drug and alcohol literature for elementary schools; \$400 check to Jack Wisdom, of Young Life, to send several kids to Young Life summer camp in Colorado; Operation Closeup, paying part of the cost of a study trip to Washington for Clear Lake and Clear Creek High School students; partial funding for four students to attend Boys State and Girls State; \$500 to the San Jacinto District of the Girl Scouts for supplies needed in the process of earning merit badges; \$750 for camperships for Boy Scout Troop 950 at the Youth Village; \$500 to Boy Scout Handicapped Troop 511 to support 4 week summer day camp camperships; and bus transportation for youth from the Bay Area to attend a Houston Symphony concert.
