Dear Mr. Tarnavski;

I received your Fax of 17 May 90 but I have not received a Fax from Mr. Igor Kostikov of the CYO. I hope this means that Sergei Adamov's arrangements are still going to work out for this summer.

It is difficult for me to understand just what is required there for this youth exchange to occur, but I hope that we are successful in accomplishing it as the pioneering youth exchange between Rotary District #589 and Moscow.

From my perspective, I would hope that your Rotary Club would officially endorse this exchange, that the CYO would do so also, and that by summer 1991 we will have a more smoothly organized exchange program worked out.

As far as the official role of either Sergei Adamov or Natalia Komarova, we have extended a personal invitation to both of them to stay in American homes, but their accompanying the students is not an official part of the exchange on this end either. We are just happy to have them as special guests. What we are looking for is your Rotary Club to embrace this particular exchange of students because all of the details and matching has been done. In the future, we do not want any adults to come along. That is not the Rotary formula.

Perhaps your Rotary Club could assign someone to serve as the coordinator from this point. I especially need to hear the specific flight times so I can make some arrangements on this end for the Soviet students to fly from New York to Houston paid in rubles.

In addition, we would like for the American students to be invited to attend one of your Rotary meetings to bring you the banners from their sponsoring Rotary Clubs.

Also, please send me the time, day and location of your meetings. One of our committee members is coming over there soon. Alex Gabriels handles the details on our exchange with Baku. He would like to visit your club if he can coordinate.


