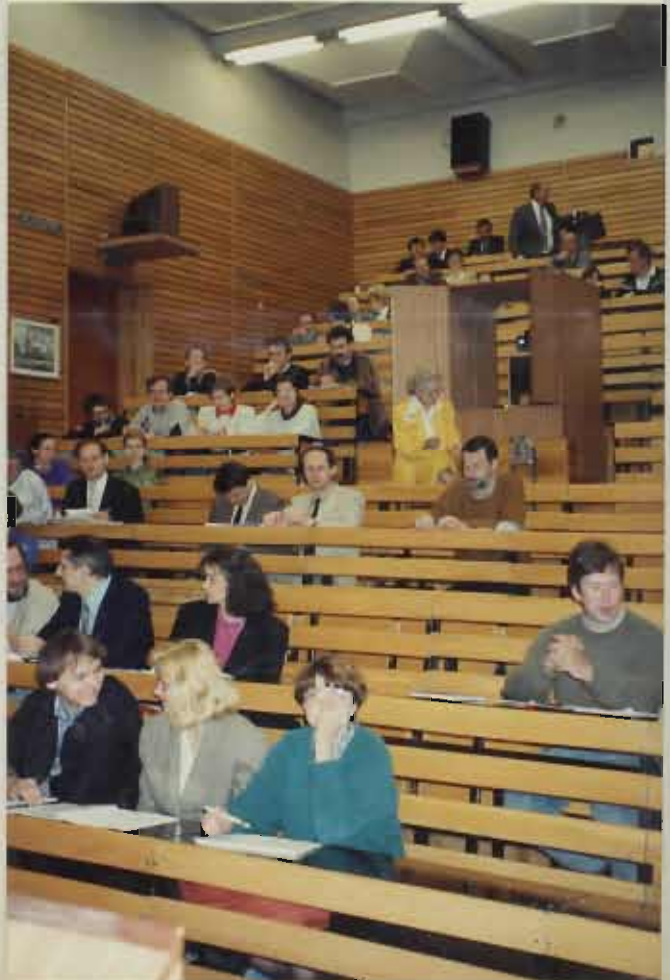

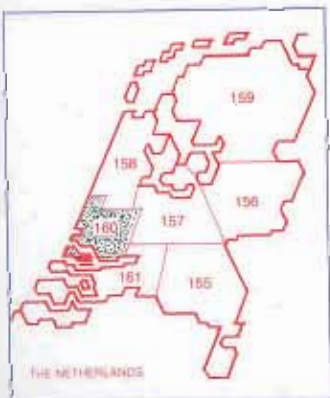

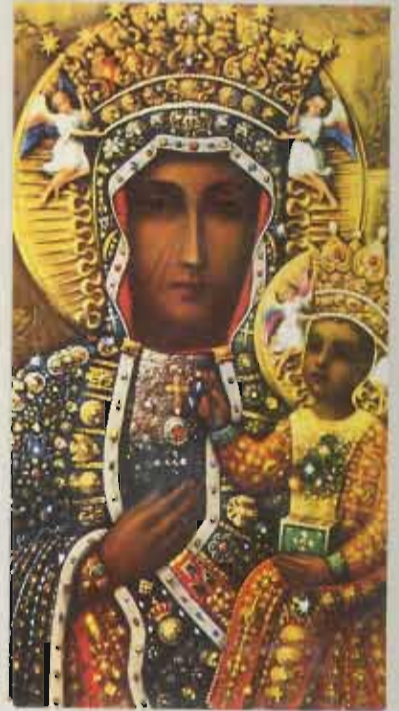

Lidka loves to dance. Also lives in one-room flat. Candy and flowers are from her patients.

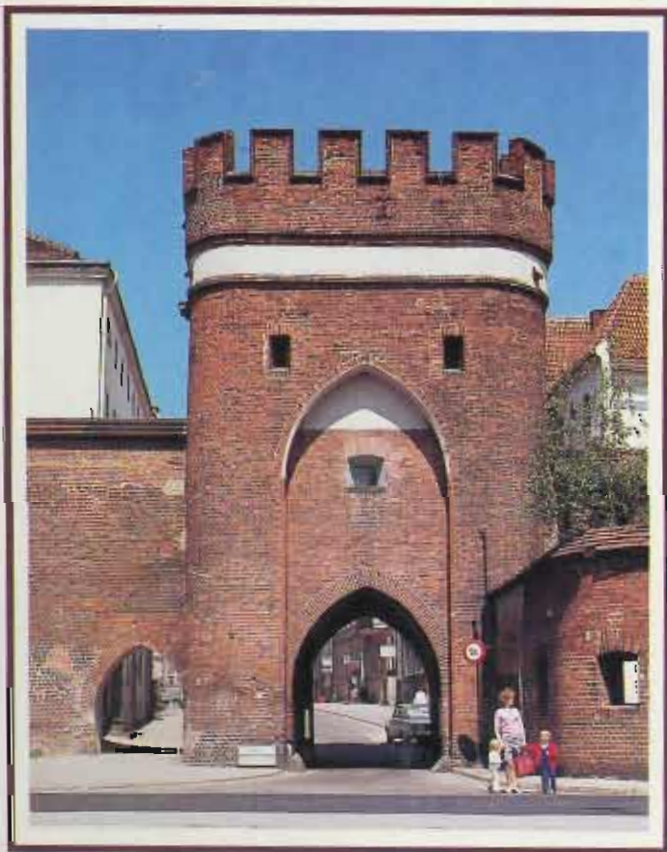


Lidka worked as a private nurse in New York City for six months. Her report on the U.S. to her friends was less than positive.
