Space Center Rotary Club (Club) Document Storage and Retrieval System
Rotary Year 2007-08
June 23, 2008

Currently the History committee consists of Jerrold Dewease

- The Club's records are currently stored in an environmentally controlled area at Extra Space Storage
- Draft criteria have been developed and the records generally organized according to these criteria
- The records will eventually be electronically stored. A website was obtained on March 1, 2008 and the draft storage and retrieval system has been installed.
- Retrieval format and templates are been developed
- Information can be retrieved on a Rotary year basis and by word search
- All documents will have a word search capability and photographs will be titled for retrieval
- For convenience, the web site home page will have categories to chose from such as the Board minutes or the Blastoff
- In addition, there will be a pull down window based on the Rotary year for a summary of each Rotary year. This summary will also be used a navigator to the stored information for that Rotary year
- Further an ongoing summary will be developed from year 1964 to the present
- Status is as follows:
- All of year 1964 (year Club started) documents have been scanned, two pages of year 1964 documents have been entered for test purposes to check out the search function
- The website home page has been completed and installed
- March 30, 2008 Blastoff has been entered for retrieval and search check

The feasibility and the continuing cost of the system will be determined after all of he templates have been developed and the system workable.
