It was severely crushed and has not been healing properly. He will need a skin graft and will not be able to work until April at the earliest. All he has is Medicare and his social security just barely covers his rent (\$595 or something like that). He stayed in the hospital and rehab for as long as Medicare would cover and now is depending on home health care. No money for electricity, car insurance, cell phone, etc.
