I would like to propose that one of Rotary's 50 acts of kindness go Clear Lake Elementary. Clear Lake Elementary is a Title school which means they serve a lot of at risk hard ship kids. Last year they were awarded pilot program where the 5th grade class was given small windows note books to use at school. The note book is a great idea because it will allow the kids to catch up on some of the technology and an internet world that is lacking at home. The problem with the note books is they did not come with external key boards or a mouse. If you use the screen couch key board. There is little room to view anything else. The solution is where we can help. I have been in contact with Kari Euker at the school where she is a counselor. She was able to find external keyboards with a mouse for only \$7.89 and a set of head phones for only \$3.75. This means combined the set would cost \$11.64. The program is being expanded to the 4th grade as well this year. The school is in need of 90 sets in order to have 10 sets per class for both grades. The total cost would be \$1047.60 tax free. I could cover the cost that exceed the \$1000 budget.

I feel this would be a wonderful act of kindness since we would be able to help a lot of kids with a small contribution.
