Matthew and Brittany Brooks are the parents of a young daughter, Sarah, age seven months. At the time the family came to Project Joy and Hope a few months ago, they were homeless, at the local hospice, and waiting for a way to take their medically fragile child home with hospice care services.

Through the PJH program, the family was moved to our Tulip Project, where hospice services are provided through a local provider, and the family is now stably housed, with utilities and shelter provided free of charge.

Their baby has a poor life expectancy. The parents were both employed, but father has now lost his minimum wage job as a result of not being able to get back and forth to work. Their car recently broke down. The 2002 Mountaineer they were driving needs a new engine, and they have yet to afford to have the car repaired.
