I just wanted once again to thank you all for supporting camp once again this year. I can tell you from personal experience that one weekend watching these families and children at camp can be lifechanging. We spent Friday Sept 16th-Sunday Sept. 18th at Camp For all with 23 Families, all with special needs children ranging from autism and downsyndrome to medically fragile and wheel chair bound. They zip-lined, rode horses, canoed, fished and painted family flags. In the end, I saw smiles on every single attendee's face.

Just 20 minutes of talking to a parent who attended with her family and extremely autistic daughter revealed that this is not only the only vacation they can afford to take every year (it's free because of wonderful supporters like the Space Center Rotary) but it is also the only place they can take their daughter and feel safe and comfortable that no one will stare or make them feel ostracized. Everyone at Camp Be An Angel is the same and by Sunday everyone is family.
