Several open items were resolved and new ones opened up. These are as follows:

Mike will talk to Earl Maudlin about the equipment trailer

Mike will talk to Courtney Lindberg about being in charge of selling meal tickets

Jerrold will contact the band used last year and ask them to perform again this year

Will the Clown be used again?

We will have safety, health and educational activities again this year. Phil Sandlin has agreed to do the kids IDing per Art Oswald. He will be approached about having the K-9 corp. and to do CPR training. Vissett Sun will be approached above having eye testing again. Jerrold has action items.

The Teachers of the Year and the Firefighter winners will be asked to come, given meal tickets, and be recognized during the Shrimporee. Who to handle invitations and guest while at the Shrimporee?

Only one gate will be open during the early part of the Shrimporee but all gates opened at the end for better egress. Two parking spaces will be blocked off on each side of the main gate entrance so the entrance can be more visible and for easier ingress. The one gate approach is to channel the guests to one path that will have informational signs.

Greg Smith presented guidelines for the preparation of the baskets for the silent auction

Paul McLarty agreed to be Marilyn's co chair in the food serving lines

The price of the meal ticket will be \$15 again this year.

Price of soft drinks and bottled water \$1, beer \$2 and wine \$3????

Add small posters to top of table at ticket counter for people to see the cost of items. There is a large sign overhead, but is inconvenient to look up at. Also David Sincox suggested a large poster on the brick wall next to the ticket sales table with the sponsors on it.

Mike will get with Kippy Caraway about doing the PR and the VIP escort

Art Oswald asked if the clean up activity would be placed under him. The committee agreed and Art will ask Slade Lewis to be in charge of general clean-up again. Art is looking for about 5-6 more persons to help him. Greg Smith gave Art the name of Nancy Mallini <u>nmallini@ccisd.net</u> as contact for the student volunteers.

Need to determine what to feed the student volunteers. Adult volunteers get meal plates.
