

Fourth Shrimporee Planning Meeting Notes
July 27, 2010

The fourth Shrimporee planning meeting was held on July 27 at the JSC FCU from 5:30 pm to 6:45 pm. Those in attendance were Mike Dennard, Marilyn Musial, Art Oswald, Alan Wylie, Marsene Boldt, Billy Smith, Geoff Atwater, Brian Ellis, John Nugent, and Jerrold Dewease. Mike Dennard presided.

The status of the open items and new ones are as follows:
