CHARLES AND JENNIE LOU HAD TWO SONS; CHARLES RICHARD RESIDING WITH HIS FAMILY IN EL PASO, TEXAS AND ROGER RESIDING WITH HIS FAMILY IN SIOUX FALLS, SOUTH DAKOTA. THEY HAVE FOUR GRAND CHILDREN AND ONE GREAT GRANDSON.

ON LEAVING THE SERVICE HE WENT TO WORK FOR J.C. PENNY FOR TWENTY YEARS. HE THEN OPENED AND OPERATED A DEPARTMENT STORE IN PASADENA. WANTING TO LIVE IN THE CLEAR LAKE AREA, HE LATER OPENED A MENS CLOTHING STORE IN CLEAR LAKE CITY.. AS JENNIE LOU PUT IT "HE FINALLY GOT TIRED OF THE RAG BUSINESS " AND DECIDED TO GET HIS REAL ESTATE LICENSE AND BECOME A COMMERCIAL REAL ESTATE BROKER – WHICH HE TRULY ENJOYED.
