



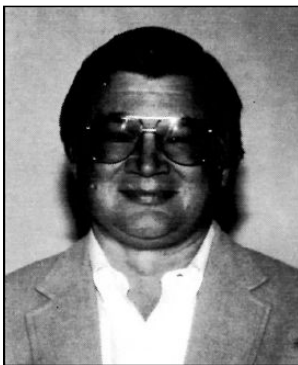
Robbye R. Waldron
