

Shrimporee Committee Meeting September 4th

Chairperson Berg called the meeting to order at 5 pm in the JSC Federal Union conference room. Becky Reitz is not available for the event but will help with a basket and will also call Rosiland Perez. Chair Berg will ask Sherry Bogus to help at the serving lines also since Kathy Dooley is not available.

Stuart Berg will be the puppy handler.

Cindy Harreld has sent a draft of the VIP letter to Chair Berg. Chair Berg has requested the names of the Public Service Winners from Constable Phil Sandlin.

Art Oswald will meet with Juan Hernandez of the Boy Scouts, and Slade Lewis Thursday to discuss general cleanup. The committee decided that the money given to service projects was separate from any community service work provided by an organization. President Musial was present. Art asked Jerrold Dewease to provide him a list of the committee chairs so he could call and get the schedule and number of student volunteers needed.

The raffle flyer and tickets format was approved, 2500 tickets and 250 flyers will be printed. The scooter will be placed at Space Center Automotive for display along with tickets to sell. The tickets and flyers should be ready by September 17.

The Shrimporee flyer and poster was approved with the sponsors being as of September 4.
