Studies show that children that are exposed to education programs over the summer months show immense improvement in summer learning loss.

Studies have found that children, parents and camp staff see improvements in positive identity, social skills, physical and thinking skills, positive values, and spirituality due to camping experiences. Our goal is to help youth acquire these building blocks to create a firm foundation for their lives and a positive identity; a strong sense of power, purpose and self-worth; and values that will enable them to make wise choices throughout life.

For those who may not be able to afford a camping experience, Camp Cullen provides financial assistance to children and teens from Houston-area communities. Those served are from children homes, foster homes, military children with parents deployed overseas and children from families living at or below the federal poverty level. These at-risk children establish a critical bond with adult role models and through this experience have demonstrated significant improvement in social skills, leadership skills, and self-confidence and character values.

Would you be so kind to consider a gift as part of your Random Act of Kindness Program to help less fortunate children attend YMCA Camp Cullen this summer? This would provide sliding scale scholarships for 3 children. It is for a full week of overnight camping.
