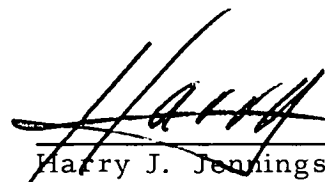
MINUTES:

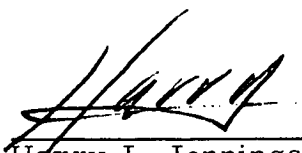
All Officers Present
