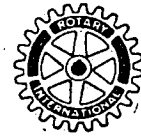

GOINGS ON ABOUT TOWN

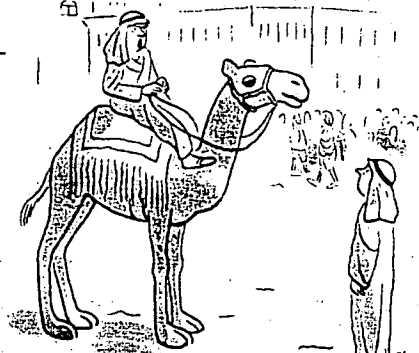
