PROCEDURES FOR PROCESSING NEW MEMBER APPLICATIONS

1. Club membership is advised of open classification (s). A classification is opened for membership proposals by the board of directors of the club.
2. Member proposer completes front part of "Membership Proposal" card and submits card to club secretary. Club Secretary notifies Club Service (B) Director of receipt of card, name of proposed member, proposer, etc. The one proposed should know nothing of this proposal.
3. Club Secretary records date of receipt of proposal card and forwards card to chairman of the Classification Committee. This date is also recorded on card.
4. Chairman of Classification Committee, after completing all the necessary classification work, records date and forwards proposal to chairman of the Membership Committee. If proposed member is rejected for any reason of classification, card with appropriate remarks, is forwarded to Club Secretary who will notify the Board of Directors and the proposer.
5. Chairman of Membership Committee, after investigating proposed member and results are positive, records date and forwards proposal card to Club Secretary. If results are negative, card, with appropriate remarks, is forwarded to Club Secretary who will notify the Board of Directors and the proposer.
6. Club Secretary submits name of proposed member to Board of Directors for review and necessary action. If proposed member is rejected, secretary will notify proposer. If board's decision is favorable, Club Service (B) Director will immediately contact Rotary Information chairman to arrange for the proposed member, the proposer & appropriate Rotary Information Committee member (s) to meet to properly orient proposed member.

*Note: Until this approval is granted the prospect should not be informed that his name has been proposed for membership.

7. Rotary Information Committee orients proposed member. After the proposed member has an understanding of the requirements and conditions of Rotary membership and still wishes to become a Rotarian, he will complete a Membership Application card furnished by a Rotary Information Committee member. If proposed member does not wish to become a Rotarian (at this point), Rotary Information committee chairman will notify club service (B) Director and Club Secretary who will notify the Board and Proposer of rejection.
8. Rotary Information Committee chairman will forward completed Application Card to Club Secretary and will immediately notify Club Service (B) Director that briefing has been completed & that application card has been forwarded to Club Secretary.
9. Club Service (B) Director will immediately complete the ten day notice form and post it at the next scheduled meeting.
10. After a ten day waiting period, club secretary will notify the club that the applicant is qualified for membership and will make arrangements with the Club President to induct the new member into the club.
