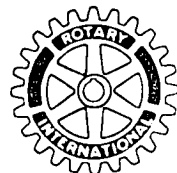

### PROGRAMS:

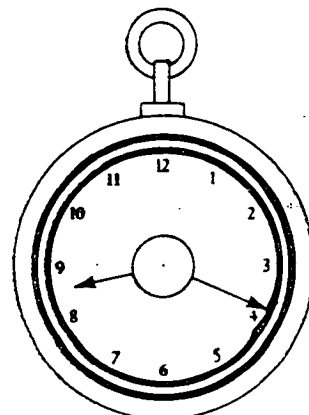

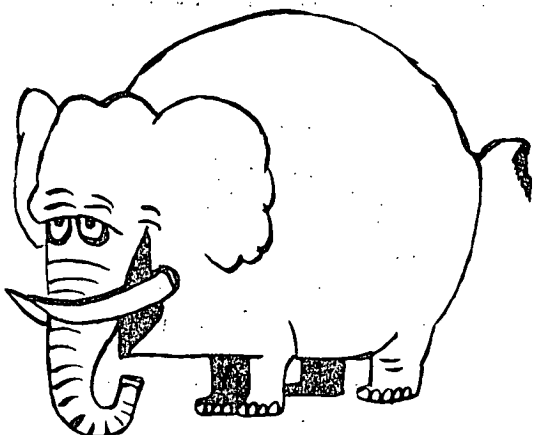
