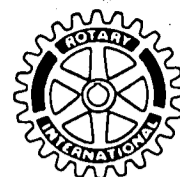

PAST PROGRAMS....On July 26th, ALFRED NEUMANN introduced GWEN HUMMELL and DAVID CLARK of the Honeywell Protection Services who presented a program on Crime Prevention. The program was aimed at the different ways a person could use to protect his home and possessions against burglary. They utilized a series of slides showing how each person could evaluate his own home and devise ways of increasing security protection. An excellent talk on one part of the judiciary system that hopefully will be followed by others to fully explain the total judiciary system.

ROTARY COMMITTEES AT WORK....

Attendance Committee. RULES FOR THE SCOOTERS HANDICAP. The Rotary Club puts \$5.00 in the Scooters Handicap Kitty each week. At each meeting, one name is drawn from the membership. The individual whose name is drawn is the winner of the funds accumulated in the Kitty if he is present, at the time his name is called, and is wearing his Rotary pin and name badge. Note; the name drawing is the last item on the meeting agenda.
