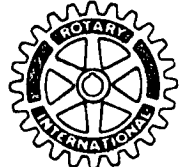

MONDAY, DECEMBER 20TH.....Program Pending. Be on the lookout for another outstanding program from your Program Committee.

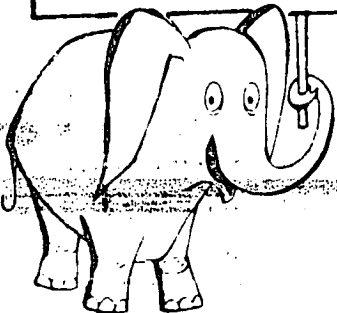
MONDAY, DECEMBER 27TH.....A special Fellowship program under the direction of BILLY BURT and AL LIGRANI. Don't miss this program.
