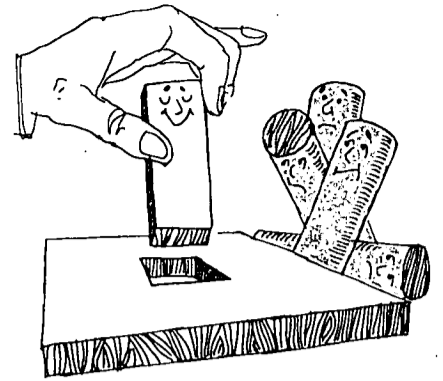

EFFECTIVE JANUARY 7TH.....

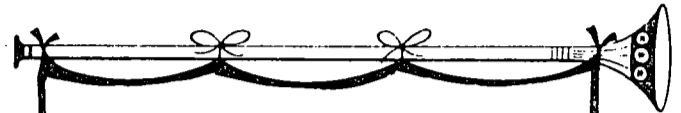

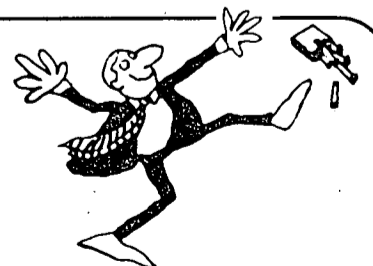
