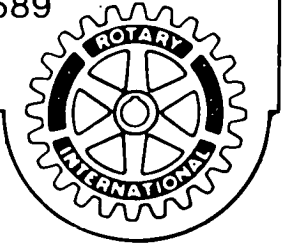

**Thurs., Oct. 19** at Bay Forest Golf Club. Annual Club Championship Tournament.

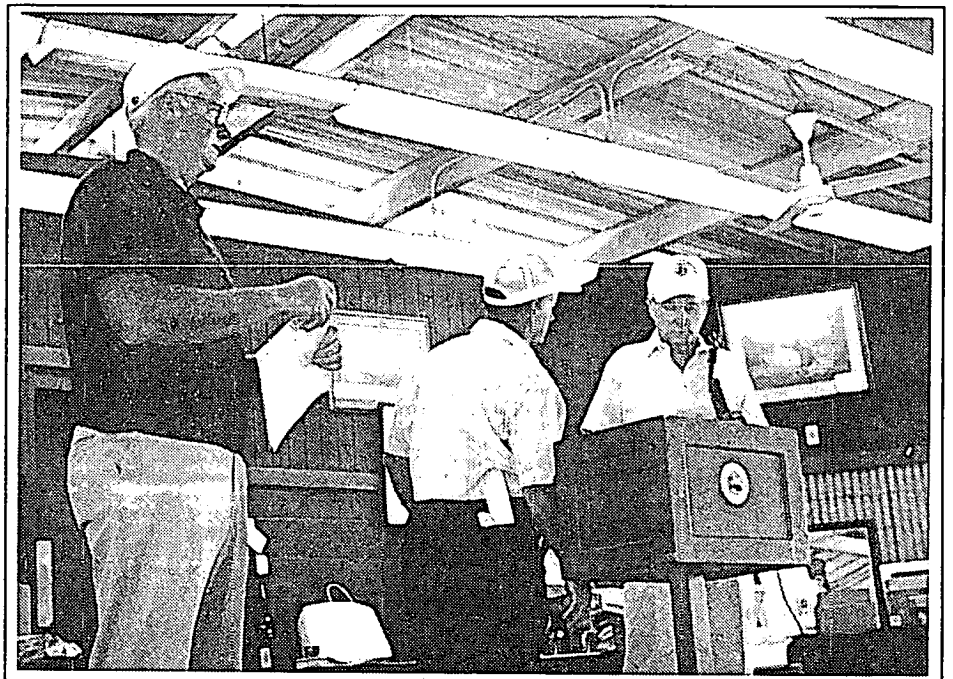

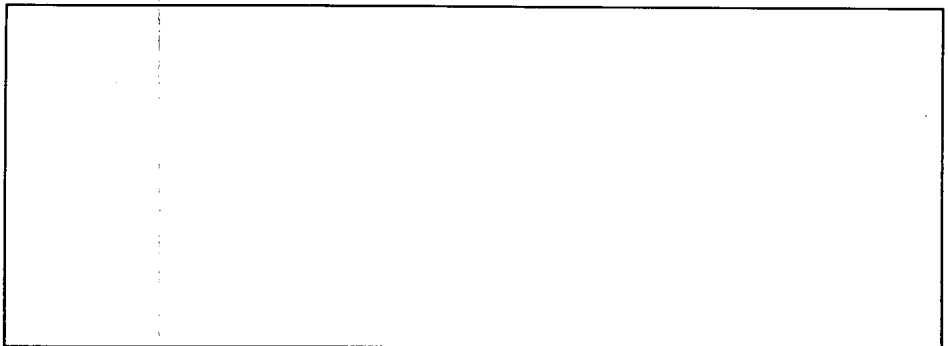

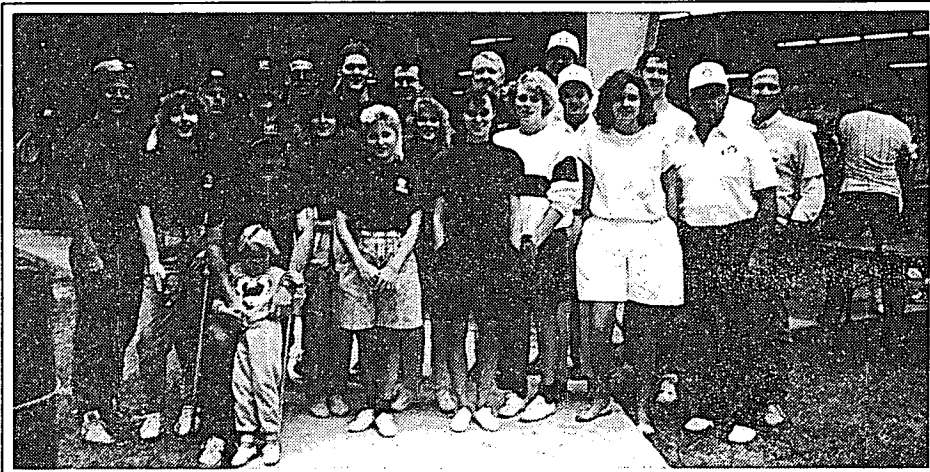
