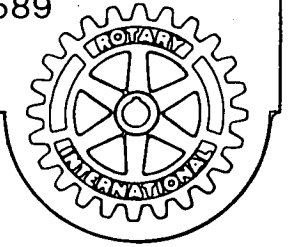

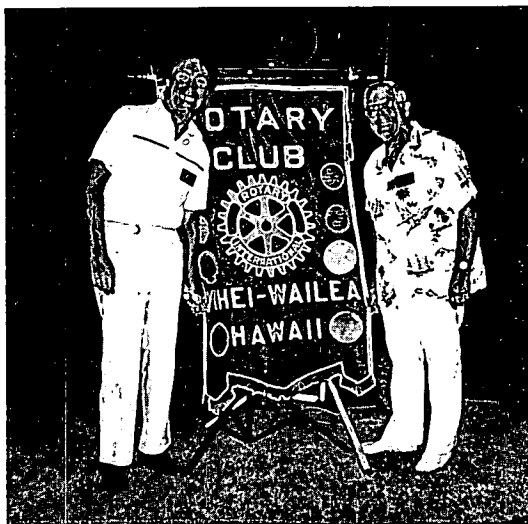


In Memorium

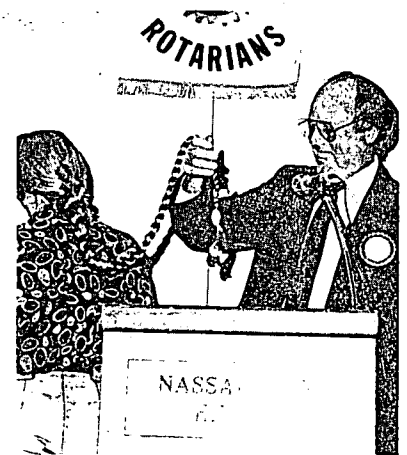
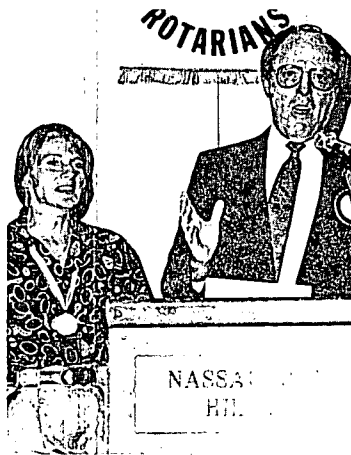

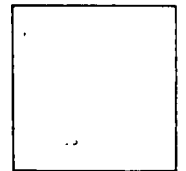
