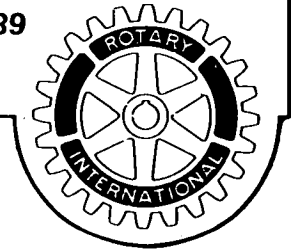

Enterprising Youth Camp

Some 23 Rotary clubs in North America sponsor camps to teach young people about the free enterprise system. On July 20, the First Annual National Conference on Camp Enterprise was held at DFW Hyatt Regency Hotel in Dallas, Texas.

The program focuses on topics to help the campers understand such business basics as what it takes to bring a product to market, what a business plan is, and what it means to provide good service. It also deals with the young people's concerns such as preserving the natural environment.

The first Camp Enterprise was started in 1966 by the Rotary Club of Columbus, Ohio. It lasted three days and brought together 22 high school students with 22 Rotarians and nine other business leaders. They talked about such topics as "How to Start a Business", "A Philosophy of Business" and "Business and the Community". Paul Workman of the Austin Rotary Club and Organizer of this summer's event said that there have been refinements since the Columbus club's first camp, but the original objectives remain unchanged.
