Greater Bay Area Relay For Life

Gretchen Umberger is an area realtor and team recruitment chair for the 2005 Greater Bay Area Relay For Life. Gretchen first became involved in Relay For Life to honor her late husband and is further driven by friends and family currently fighting their battle with cancer.

Elaine Dollar is the Greater Bay Area Relay For Life American Cancer Society Support Staff and the program manager of Health Initiatives for the Houston Metro American Cancer Society office. Elaine has been with Houston Metro ACS for 13 years and her focus is on education, prevention, early detection and services for cancer patients.

What Is Relay?

Relay For Life is a community gathering where everyone can participate in the fight against cancer. Teams of people camp out at a local high school, park or fairground and take turns walking or running around a track or a path. Each team is asked to have a representative on the track at all times during the event because cancer never sleeps. Relays are an overnight event, up to 24 hours in length.

Relay For Life brings together millions of people in over 4000 communities nationwide to raise money to help prevent cancer, save lives, and diminish suffering from the disease. While you're raising much needed funds, you'll also be raising awareness of cancer prevention, early detection, treatment, and patient support. Relay brings people together from all walks of life with the common goal of eliminating cancer. No matter who you are, there's a place for you at Relay.

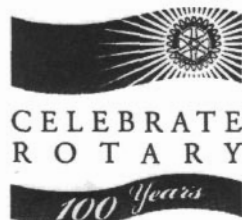
