The BULLETIN COMMITTEE would like to have \$750.00 budgeted for the printing and mailing of the "BLASTOFF" for the fiscal year of 1971-1972 commencing July 1, 1971. This amount will be necessary for a years supply of paper stock (issues and envelopes), address-O-graph services and postage for 7,250 mailings at 8¢ each over a 50 week period of time.

There should be no printing costs since it is my understanding that TRW Systems will continue the printing without charge for our Club providing we continue a "one-sheet-one side" issue, and this we feel necessary to do to conserve expense. The Committee however will continue its efforts to upgrade the Blastoff to make it more attractive and interesting.

Should the officers and directors feel a completely new bulletin be born (folding type with 2 or 3 color print), then we must raise an additional \$700.00 to cover the costs. This could be raised by billing each of the members \$3.00 semi-annually for a "subscription" to the Bulletin.
