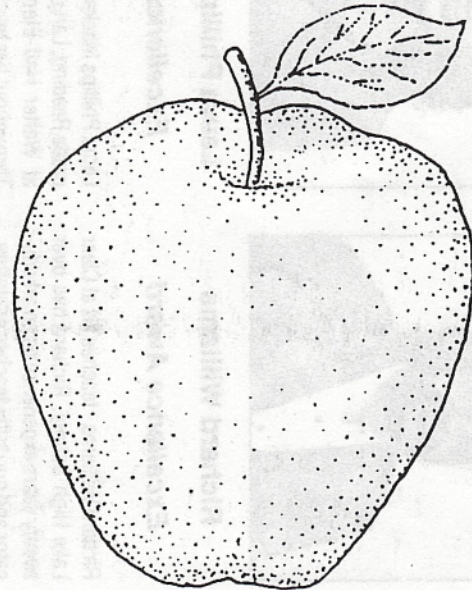

SPACE CENTER ROTARY PRESENTS 1997 EXCELLENCE IN EDUCATION AWARDS

Space Center Rotary believes the teaching profession should be honored and recognized for its contribution to our community and believes this award demonstrates its appreciation and value for our educators.

Five teachers have been selected for the Excellence in Education Award from 46 teacher nominees representing 25 schools from throughout Clear Creek Independent School District. All Clear Creek School District full-time teachers were eligible and nomination could come from anyone familiar with the educator's work.

The **Teacher of the Year** has been selected from among these five through a careful interview process. This educator will receive a Rotary International Excellence in Education Award of \$1,000 cash, an honorary Rotary membership, a personal plaque, another plaque for display at the educator's school, and the selectee's name will be placed on a perpetual plaque which is on display at the school district offices.
